

ACCESS RULES

MANDATORY RULES FOR ALL SPECTATORS



Visitors to the Mutua Madrid Open 2016 will be subject to controls established by the organization to ensure that the conditions and restrictions regarding entry to the grounds stated in the following regulations are adhered to:



Visitors must arrive with sufficient time to pass through security access controls and await their relevant entry time.



It is not advisable to bring large bags (measuring larger than a laptop bag) into the grounds. Tournament organizers recommend the use of handbags.



Backpacks will not be allowed into the Caja Magica, with the exception of schools groups granted prior approval by the tournament organizers.



According to the Royal Decree 2816/1982, Article 59, stadium access will not be permitted with any bulky items, prams/pushchairs or any other object that could cause obstruction in the case of evacuation. Access to the site will be permitted via the turnstiles but not into the 3 stadiums. A cloakroom for these items will be available on site.



All visitors agree to be recorded by closed circuit television whilst on site, at all entrances and inside the venue.



Those attending the Mutua Madrid Open agree to be submitted to body searches by security personnel, to ensure entry regulations are complied with.



In all circumstances, to ensure that entry restrictions and conditions are complied with, security personnel and the police authority will decide on the implementation of security controls, body searches, security mechanisms and other measures that may be taken in accordance with current legislation.
